Job Title: EMT

Reports to: Park Manager and Show/Event Management

Job Summary: The EMT's essential function is to ensure that anyone who needs medical attention while at the Horse Park given an evaluation, treated as necessary and given recommendations and/or instructions for further treatment or more extensive evaluation.

Qualifications:

- Manually lift up to 50lbs
- High school diploma or equivalent
- Valid motor vehicle license
- EMT-B certification or higher
- CPR/BLS/AED

Physical Requirements/Environmental Conditions:

- Requires physical exertion and manual labor including but not limited to; lifting, carrying, pulling and pushing.
- Requires kneeling, bending, climbing and reaching.
- Must work indoors and outdoors.
- Must work in conditions where there may be fumes and/or dust.

All EMTs are expected to:

- Report to work at their scheduled time
- Fill out run sheets and obtain all signatures appropriate
- Be able to work the entire length of an event and/or have another Horse Park approved EMT cover the remainder of the shift
- Use proper safety equipment
- Follow all state and federal guidelines on the treatment and care of patients
- Present themselves in a professional manner

Responsibilities: include the following.

- Inspect equipment and bags at the beginning of the shift
- Be alert and observant of activities going on
- Be cognizant and respectful of concerns of Show Management or Horse Pak Officials regarding areas that need attention
- Fill out reports for anyone who was treated at the Horse Park
